

# **Schomp Summer Program Scholarship**

### **Information & Application 2020**

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Schomp Summer Intensive Scholarship is to provide need-based support for rising DSA Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors to attend summer intensives/programs. These program opportunities should enhance the students' current artistic skills, as well as advance college admission and scholarship potential.

These funds are not intended to support:

- a.) travel to festivals or competitions by DSA-sponsored departments or programs;
- b.) attendance at DSA summer intensives; or
- c.) ensemble travel/festival participation by DSA departments.

#### **FUNDING:**

Scholarships are intended to cover a **portion of program expenses** including tuition, fees, room and board. Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need through FRDL status or a "Statement of Need" from parent/legal guardian. (Statement of Need may be included in section 5 of the Narrative Questions.)

#### **HOW TO APPLY:**

- **1.** Complete the cover sheet on the next page.
- 2. Include a typed explanation of no more than two pages addressing the narrative questions on the next page.
- 3. Contact and confirm with recommending art teacher who will be providing a personal reference.

**Application deadline is March 1, 2020**. Acceptance into a summer program is not mandatory when applying for funding, so you can apply prior to being accepted.
